The National Museum of Civil War Medicine-Pry House Field Hospital Museum and Antietam National Battlefield will sponsor two Civil War Day Camps this summer. The camps will include hikes, interactive educational programs, and hands-on activities led by park rangers and museum staff. (Parents may also participate if they wish).
